**School/Parish Hall Collection**

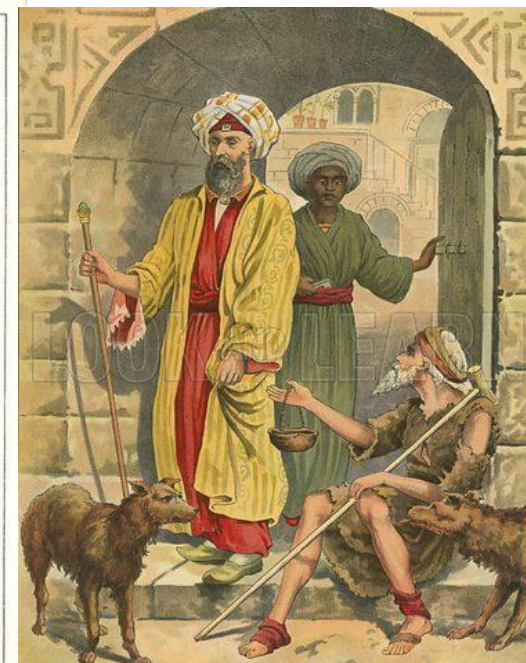
This weekend 27<sup>th</sup>/28<sup>th</sup> September 2025
