Divine Mercy Sunday

12th April 2026

Divine Mercy Sunday will be celebrated in Holy Cross Church, Charleville on Sunday, 12th April 2026.



The Ceremony will begin at 3pm (The Hour of Great Mercy) with the Procession of the Divine Mercy Image, St. Faustina's Diary and a First Class Relic of St. Faustina.

The Blessed Sacrament will be Exposed.

The Blessing of the Divine Mercy Image will then take place with some Readings about the Feast of Mercy.

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy will be recited followed by the Rosary.

Confessions will be heard and hymns will be sung throughout the Ceremony which will conclude with Benediction.

The Relic will be available for those who would like a blessing.
